

Student Chapter Program

AcademyHealth student chapters enhance the learning and professional development experience for students of health services research and health policy. Designed to promote networking, student chapters receive support from AcademyHealth in instituting programs and projects of interest. Student chapters convene annually in conjunction with AcademyHealth's National Health Policy Conference and Annual Research Meeting.

Structure

Typically, a student chapter is composed of an elected leadership of students, a faculty advisor, and students enrolled in multidisciplinary programs related to health services research and/or health policy. Each student chapter is expected to establish and uphold bylaws and activities for the academic year.
